In its review of *Bat Boy: the Musical*, the New York Times noted "it's remarkable what intelligent wit can accomplish." Based on the half-boy/half-bat creature created by Weekly World News Editor Dick Kulpa (first gracing the cover of the now-defunct tabloid on June 23, 1992), *Bat Boy: The Musical* premiered at Tim Robbins' Actors Gang Theatre on October 31, 1997. Librettists Keythe Farley and Brian Flemming, along with composer/lyricist Laurence O'Keefe, blend a complex variety of musical theater styles into their tale of comedy, horror and social commentary – to which we've added our own nods to *Frankenstein, Rose-Marie, Hamlet* and others (with a little Hitchcock and Michelangelo thrown in for good measure). Spurred on by their own economic crisis, the citizens of the aptly-named Hope Falls learn to fear, hate, try, fail, love and grow – not necessarily in that order – while coming face-to-face with what it means to be different.

This production is a unique collaboration between the student-run Undergraduate Theater Society (UTS) and the School of Drama. 
